Tournament Details

Venue: Southern Suburbs Chess Club, Leeming Primary School (Meharry Rd, Leeming)

Format: Swiss, 6 rounds, open to all CAWA members. ACF- and FIDE-rated.

Time Control: 90 minutes, with an increment of 30 seconds per move starting from move 1.

Schedule:	13th August:	Round 1	3rd September:	Round 4
	20th August:	Round 2	10th September:	Round 5
	27th August:	Round 3	17th September:	Round 6

All rounds will begin at 7:30pm.

The default time will be 30 minutes after the start of the playing session.

Players must contact the organiser if they cannot be present for a particular round.

Closing Date: 9:00pm, Monday 12th August.

Notes:

- 1. End Date:** All games must be played by Tuesday 17th September. Any games that are played after the final round date will not be included in the tournament results and will not be rated. All scoresheets should be submitted to the arbiters by this date. Any results that are not known to the arbiters will be entered as double forfeits.
- 2. Publication of Pairings and Results:** Official pairings will be posted at the venue, immediately prior to the start of the round. Provisional pairings for Rounds 2 – 6 will be posted on the club website, but these will be marked as provisional and may be subject to change at any time depending on player availability. Updated results and tournament PGN files will be emailed to players during the tournament.
- 3. Half-point byes:** A player may choose to take up to 2 half-point byes, for any of Rounds 1 – 5, provided they have not already received 1 or more points in byes or forfeits. Players seeking half-point byes must inform the organiser before commencement of the preceding round.

Prizes: 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and rating prizes depending on entries.
Prizes will be awarded at the SSCC Allegro Championship on 24th September.

Entry Fee: \$25 (SSCC members) \$35 (SSCC non-members)
In order to receive the SSCC membership discount, players must pay their SSCC membership fee prior to the start of the tournament. Players doing so will receive SSCC and CAWA membership from the start of the tournament until the end of 2019.
