Tournament Details

Venue: Southern Suburbs Chess Club, Leeming Primary School (Meharry Rd, Leeming)

Format: Swiss, 7 rounds, open to all CAWA members. ACF- and FIDE-rated.

Time Control: 90 minutes, with an increment of 30 seconds per move starting from move 1.

Schedule:

5th February: Round 1	5th March: Round 5
12th February: Round 2	12th March: Round 6
19th February: Round 3	19th March: Round 7
26th February: Round 4	

All rounds will begin at 7:30pm.

The default time will be 30 minutes after the start of the playing session.

Players must contact the organiser if they cannot be present for a particular round.

Closing Date: 9:00pm, Monday 4th February.

Notes:

- 1. End Date:** All games must be played by Tuesday 19th March. All scoresheets should be submitted to the arbiters by this date. Any games that are played after the final round date will not be included in the tournament results and will not be rated. Any results that are not known to the arbiters will be entered as double forfeits.
- 2. Publication of Pairings and Results:** Official pairings will be posted at the venue, immediately prior to the start of the round. Provisional pairings for Rounds 2 – 7 will be posted on the club website, but these will be marked as provisional and may be subject to change at any time depending on player availability. Updated results and tournament PGN files will be emailed to players during the tournament.
- 3. Half-point byes:** A player may choose to take up to 2 half-point byes, for any of Rounds 1 – 5. Players seeking half-point byes must inform the organiser before 6:00pm on the Sunday prior to the relevant round.

Prizes: 1st, 2nd, 3rd, plus rating division prizes depending on entries.
Prizes will be awarded at the SSCC Autumn Blitz Tournament on 26th March.

WA Grand Prix: The 2019 Southern Suburbs Open is registered as part of the 2019 WA Grand Prix. Grand Prix points will be awarded to participants in different categories. At the end of the year, the points from all Grand Prix tournaments will be combined, and the Paul Meyer awards will be presented to the leading players in each category.

Entry Fee: \$25 (SSCC members) \$35 (SSCC non-members)
In order to receive the SSCC membership discount, players must pay their 2019 SSCC membership fee prior to the start of the tournament.

Australian residents who do not yet have FIDE ID numbers will be registered with FIDE through the ACF, and do not need to take any action.
Non-residents who do not yet have FIDE ID numbers must ask their appropriate foreign federation to assign them one before they can enter. Players registered under a wrong federation may incur considerable transfer costs later.
