 30th July: Rounds 5 and 6 **6th August:** Rounds 7 and 8

- All odd-numbered rounds will begin at 7:30pm. Even-numbered rounds will be played shortly after the conclusion of the preceding round.
- Players may choose to take up to 2 half-point byes, but not for Round 7 or 8.
