This tournament is open to all chess players of any experience or ability. Whether you are a seasoned club player, haven't played for some time or have come to chess via the internet and would like to try the real thing – you are welcome.

This is a five-round tournament with a time control of 50 minutes per player and an additional 10 seconds added per move. This allows for serious rated games while being a good introduction to longer form chess for those less experienced players.
